WHO CAN APPLY?

Interns are required to:

- be enrolled at an Australian university.
- have completed at least three years of an undergraduate program, with an aspiration to go on to study Honours. Exceptional candidates may be considered after 2 years of under-graduate study
- have a minimum "Credit" average, with an emphasis on high grades in subjects of relevance to the project.
